

2020/21 SRWC ROAD WORKS PERFORMANCE REVIEWS

PROPOSALS FOR MONITORING

With the onset of the Covid-19 Pandemic in March 2020, and the subsequent restrictions on daily life and business activity, it will be impossible for this office to review each organisation's performance in a similar format to previous years. The initial disruption from late March and through the summer resulted in a number of road works performance measures being negatively affected as organisations responded to the restrictions. This, in turn, has affected their reliability as a yearly performance measure.

However, it is apparent that the majority of organisations managed to return their performance indicators to somewhere approaching pre-pandemic levels during Quarter 3 and into Quarter 4 and the efforts by all Road Authorities and Utility Companies is acknowledged.

PROPOSAL

It is therefore proposed that the 2020/21 Annual Performance Reviews will include:-

- The data covering the period April to September 2020 (i.e. Quarter 1 and Quarter 2) will be provided for information only.
- The yearly performance review figures will concentrate on an aggregated figure for the third and fourth quarters only for each of the individual indicators.
- The "Specific Actions" section will still identify areas of non-compliance concentrating on aggregated Quarter 3 and Quarter 4 performance and will note specific areas where improvement is required.
- The "Summary" section will include reports on "Noticing Failure" and "Unplanned Works" aggregated Quarter 3 and Quarter 4 performance for year 2020/21 against year 2019/20.
- The "Summary" section may also include an assessment of compliance with noticing advice during the restricted period due to Covid-19.

 An overall performance assessment using terminology along the lines of "requires improvement", "satisfactory" and "good".

It is hoped that the above approach will acknowledge the unique circumstances of 2020/21 whilst still providing a reasonable assessment of each organisation's road works performance during the period.
