11. South West RAUC and RAUC Scotland

South West RAUC

- 11.1 The new Transport Act will have a briefing meeting, held in April.
- 11.2 Authorities may be required to submit quality plans
- 11.3 They are reviewing the constitution of RAUCS with a view of reducing the overall number of meetings. Some local coordination area meetings could be joined together, with the frequency increased to every 2 months instead of 3. Area Raucs maybe join SW & WOS together so there are only 4 areas instead of 5 and reduce the frequency possibly to 3 a year instead of 4. Reduce the frequency of national RAUC. A proposal will be drafted and then circulate for comment.
- 11.4 An issue was raised about TTRO in some areas granting residents access to their properties when it wasn't feasible due to the site works. Requested made that care is taken when producing the TTRO and discussions are carried out with utilities before TTRO are produced.
- 11.5 Openreach data should be available within Vault near summer time, tests are ongoing now.

RAUC Scotland

- 11.6 Revision to the Inspection Code was approved at yesterdays RAUC Scotland meeting. This will be live from the 1st April 2020.
- 11.7 Material options within SRWR are being reviewed to include narrow trenching and cold lay.
- 11.8 Traffic Signal working group has been setup to review advice note 8.
- 11.9 The Quality Plan working group will now include to road authority representatives.
- 11.10 The 2020 HAUC UK Conference will be held again in Manchester on 14th May 2020.
- 11.11 Office of the Scottish Road Works Commissioner Annual Report is due shortly.
- 11.12 Estimated cost for next years SRWR contribution will be sent to each organisation now with the invoice being issued on the 1st April.
- 11.13 SRWR currently has 2200 users, so far only 7% have sat the Aurora training.
- 11.14 Secondary legislation for the new Transport Act is currently still being developed.
