4.1.1	General	
	Invoicing – Stirling advised they are sending out paper invoices. Paper invoices are not reaching SGN as all their invoices are electronic now. AD advised that PDF invoices are sent to sgn.ap@sse.com . GB says to keep open to see what DC says.	DC/AD
	EH mentioned that was a SW notice sitting at Works Closed but the site was still open (Dock Street, Bo'ness). Barriers kept falling into the open excavation. Site has been FPN'd. SW have been asked already to undertake this as a matter of urgency. JD passed details to SW.	
	GB advised that Stirling are monitoring an influx of urgent notices from Clancy for lead renewals on embargo routes.	
4.2	Programme of Major Works & General- Co-ordination	
	EH – all Falkirk planned resurfacing works will be noticed in Symology as	
	and when dates are known/planned. GB – advised that this is the same for Stirling.

	It was noted that works required near polling stations on 12 December should be avoided unless there is an emergency. Falkirk have placed nonworks disruptions into Symology. GB noted works at A84 Collie north of Doune – 07:00hrs until 19:00hrs	
	during the day from 24 until 27 February. Bridge of Teith at Doune going to be closed from Saturday 12 January until Saturday 1 February. There will be a diversion in place & the distillery road will still be open. Narrow bridge closed only.	
	Utilities – no major works were raised.

	EH noted that Falkirk's sample inspection figures were very good. SPEN, SW and SGN were all sitting at 100% for sample inspection figures from 2019 Q2. EH thanked the utilities for their good work.	
	JD stated that he had FPN'd 3 jobs in the last 2 days in the Falkirk area. GB – SPEN's sample inspection figures have improved since new contractors have taken over (Spratt Multi Utility).	
	SB noted that Stirling continue to have issues with CityFibre and their low figures on the inspection report are addressed at weekly meetings with them.

	No concerns with this report were noted.	
4.4	Traffic Sensitivity, Proposed Changes to Road Designations and Engineering Difficulties	
	EH and GB stated there was no proposed changes to road designations.	
	AD advised that 4 skeletons were found in Murray Place, Stirling when	
	digging and had to dig with caution thereafter. Requirement for archaeologists when digging more than 900mm deep. Damaged patch here & hole patch to be taken out. SGN were thanked for their assistance and helpfulness with this.

	It was noted that conventions have changed. Authorities using Roadnet have major changes to undertake at a cost. Further update to be provided at the next meeting.

	EH asked the group if were happy for the agenda to be updated and

	GB mentioned that SGN were still using hangman signs on major works & that the jobs weren't being checked daily or being bagged which isn't	

	adequate for major works. In use at Murray Place.	
	JD said that the signs in Kinneil Road, Bo'ness weren't doubled covered.	
	GB said that he was picking up signs/barriers that hadn't been double	
	bagged due to the weather. Utilities should make the safe before going	
	home. AD advised 1000 sandbags coming next Wednesday.	
	EH & JD mentioned again that the barriers were all down in Dock street,	
	Bo'ness.
