# **Highland Council, Roads and Transport:**

#### **Inverness:**

Alasdair Brown was representing instead of Alistair Macleod. He stated the previous program was still valid and added in a few other resurfacing works mentioned below:

Bruce Gardens has a day time closure between 12/09/22 – 16/09/22

Seafield Road has a night time closure between 19/09/22 – 23/09/22

Harbour Road has a night time closure between 22/09/22 – 23/09/22

Telford Street has a night time closure between 03/10/22 – 07/10/22

Carsgate Road has a night time closure between 10/10/22 – 14/10/22

All works have road restrictions notices on Auroua.

# Caithness & Sutherland:

Jonathan Gunn stated all surface dressing works had been completed in the Caithness area but took longer than advised due to materials issues. They are going to continue to do resurfacing works in the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September 2022 and will continue with capital works.

Sutherland started their surface dressing programme but had to stop due to the same issues mentioned above, so it hasn't been completed.

# **Street Lighting Issues:**

#### Roads

Surface dressing has been completed all over Moray.

They are now starting works to resurface the North East Buckie area and all the works are on the system.

They have repairs at the Black water Bridge on A941 between 26/09/22- 04/12/22

On the A941 North Elgin they are widening the Road on 20/11/22

Orchard Road Forres plans to widen the pavement and traffic signals.

A1180 – Bridge closure on 30/10/22 and a diversion will be in place.

It was also mentioned that The Moray West Wind Farm project that was brought up at the last meeting is to trench cables across the country.

Jonathan Gunn- asked who was providing Moray with Bitumen and Colin replied he didn't know but would find out.
