Utilities should supply traffic Management details and programmes of works timeously where appropriate JS – NLC Surfacing programme is in SRWR CS – Owing to Covid Restrictions the majority of East Dunbartonshire surfacing works not completed in 20/21, therefore works to be carried forward to 21/22 and are in the Register. <p>CS – Major surfacing works due on Switchback Rd, Bearsden for July. It was noted that SW had major works proposed for Coronation Way nearby. Surfacing in Auchenhowie Rd, Milngavie is due in June.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SSu – Bellziehill Roandabout will be closed on the south side for bridge works during the school holidays. The R.As will need to appoint Lead Authorities • Changes to Advice Note 8 for TTLS are still ongoing. • A draft of changes to Advice Note 4 for Inspection charges was circulated. • Working Group Recruitment :- • SROR W.G. – A Representative is still required from the WoS Area. • Coring W.G. – A replacement is required from SPEN to replace Lisa Haston. • Gazetteer Group – Alan Bowman is no longer on the W.G. A volunteer will be found for the Chair and the WG Representative to replace Alan. • UEFA Championships / CoP 26 and Spaces for People all affect works programmes and discussions with R.As are needed. • H.&S Executive were carrying out checks on Covid Security on sites. • All requests for alternative reinstatements (in line with the SROR and the guidance given) are to be considered favourably in all geographic areas. The guidance from the Scottish Government is to reduce interactions across Scotland. • Policy Development Group :- • Except for the requirements on reinstatements there have been no new guidance issued for dealing with Covid. • Following a recommendation from the SRWR Steering Group, it was agreed that Vault data should be supplied every 2 months. • The review of the split of the Fees and Amounts was raised for discussion.
