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	<p>Autolink</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jordan Robertson – all works are in register and are outwith SLC area. <p>Balfour</p> <p>JMcC – Nothing major planned other than barrier repairs which are recorded on the register.</p> <p>Bear SE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SR – overnight road closure for resurfacing A702 starting 22 Feb for 5 nights. 6.0	<p>Performance</p> <p>DC noted Performance Reports will be taken to the Area RAUC – these are published quarterly on the Commissioners Website and available to each organisation via Aurora.</p>	
7.0	<p>Sample/Defect Inspections/Defective Apparatus</p> <p>VP presented a report showing current SLC Inspection Report of Outstanding Defects and Resolved Defects for last quarter (as at 08/02/2022). The report was issued in advance of meeting within the package issued with the meeting request.</p> <p>Inspections Report</p> <p>PB – remedial works on open joints in winter is an issue, difficult to carry out remedials in this weather. Approved material needs to be laid when road is dry/clean at right temperature in order to lay as per the requirements. VP suggested that they are looked at in an individual basis.</p> <p>DC suggested that raised at RAUC. SROR under review and happy to take these into account and work together as regards. If SW wish to use alternative materials, then further discussions are required.</p>	

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	<p>Defects report</p> <p>VP presented to meeting defects completed and outstanding. This consists of what is outstanding on SLC01 list currently inspected every 10 to 17 days depending on the risk level.</p> <p>DC noted the cost of resources in inspecting these defects. And asked that everyone keep an eye on these to ensure they are rectified as soon as possible.</p> <p>Rosebank/Lanark Road – PB asked for update. VP noted the Grant Newbigging (SLC) has spoken to Craig McQueen (SW) and confirmed SLC are require night shift working due to the location. DC noted that the NLC Horsley Brae works have resumed, and this would form the diversion route. DC keen to take discussions forward to resolve the issue. DC asked for proposals to be submitted by SW of the options for consideration. PB noted safety concerns re working nightshift.</p>	PB

10.0	<p>Health and Safety/Traffic Management</p> <p>Health and Safety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DC to circulate any future Health & Safety bulletins to group as part of the papers. • SLC covid restrictions - as per government guidelines <p>Traffic Management</p> <p>Incidents raised last time taken to Area RAUC. DC put to group for any specific issues.</p> <p>PB – SW changing their pedestrian provision – terminology for pedestrian vehicle management. DC agreed this is being looked at from local authority. Agreed this should be looked at by all. Red book for guidance and new Highway Code changes highlighting cycles and pedestrians all need to be considered when looking at TM and worth reminding everyone.</p> <p>Phil Boylan - Environment and Sustainability – SW looking at more road closures on side streets to remove the need for 3 and 4 way lights and keep traffic flowing. This should also help reduce the duration of works. DC agreed and noted the cost of this can be offset with the cost of Traffic Management moving TM around, downtime etc. DC noted safe pedestrian management would be to move to other walkway and not on the road around the works inside barriers. Road closures should be utilised more.</p> <p>DC noted PR and communication on social media is a benefit to reduce customer complaints before road works.</p> <p>CMcT noted Axione seen a difference with PR prior to works being on site in reducing customer complaints.</p> <p>Dave Allen – emphasises this as Traffic Scotland’s website regularly ask for coms/media to upload. Everyone to take back and discuss. PB – SW pass coms info to local authority PR to publish and provide same messages when complaints</p> <p>Karen Davidson, HQ Council Office Almada Street, generic inbox DC can provide update info if required.</p> <p>DC asked that everyone keep up on PR.</p>	DC

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11.0	<p>SRWR/AURORA/GAZETTEER</p> <p>Roadworks Register – DC advised the group SLC will move to an up front payment for Road Opening Permits / road closures and Traffic Light permits etc at the application stage on line.</p> <p>Application form for Traffic Lights and closure submissions will also become on line. DC will advise in advance of this becoming live.</p> <p>Aurora – no issues</p> <p>Gazetteer – DC as a Local Authority. Trunk road, issues Uniform system, patches to be upgraded in May. DC will email TR operators with details. J Robertson no issues for their network.</p>	DC
12.0	<p>AOCB</p> <p>DC – PB/EW at SW – The Crescent, Nethanvale LA2979673 – SGN agreement have accepted the defect for the verge where the containers were sitting and will be progressed – Grant Pollock Pathead in Douglas LA3039485 & 2859038 Open excavations need attended to. Ongoing for a time. Emma will take forward.</p> <p>Shannon Riley – 2 x defects, no notice for the works 2725523 / 2725526 Edinburgh Road Biggar, Scanlon to investigate.</p> <p>VP noted the Coring project will be added as agenda item for next time. EDC are the lead authority, VP will be looking at the sample sites and check we are not going to resurface these roads. Deadline next week and Val will issue the preferred site and alternative sites, relay method and utility to check the site and confirm it is their reinstatement. The K-hub will be used to store photos etc and sites will be agreed in keeping with the required milestones as per the coring advice note.</p> <p>John Hughes, SP – TM and sign for monitoring with a camera (for jump lights) is this privacy issue? – DC noted this is a public road and maybe DOT/police may need to issue permission??? Raised with RAUC in terms of people running lights. If this is improving safety could be positive.</p> <p>DA noted this is used by trunk road on contraflow/works and these do meet requirements. TM operatives on trunk roads use cameras. It is legal to take photographs apart from MoD sites and maybe restricted in shopping centres. Possibly being looked at by legal representatives across the industry. J Hughes – signage would need to be in place to inform that camera is in place. GP noted this is for safety of operatives on long term works. Not just for road works users.</p> <p>JH – asked about drainage gully cleaning system and do SLC have a programme</p>	

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	for unblocking – DC yes SLC have cyclic gully cleaning programme in place. Records of the gully assets – asset management plan would need to be in place to record problematic gullies. Any blocked gullies please notify SLC with photo and we will aim to get it rectified.
