	<p>There was a discussion around the contents of the Coordination document:</p> <p>Virgin Media are still occupying areas of Armadale and Bathgate and are still in the process of updating notices in Blackburn. These works still cause area of concern and should be taken into consideration.</p> <p>BT044 also have various works notified for Whitburn, Bathgate and Blackburn that have traffic management which also could lead to conflict.</p> <p>SW Capital poses a potential conflict with SW Iron for Lower Bathville that needs to be resolved</p>	

	<p>There appears to be an overlap in the closure for u29 and U38 that just needs clarified as the diversion could overlap</p> <p>Eagles View traffic management needs to be agreed.</p> <p>C9 closure – SW cap works does have the potential to conflict with the Development at Bangour not sure what the update is here but the Developer wanted to close the road asap. It was advised that works are at opposite ends of the C9.</p> <p>Scottish Power re Broxburn. Potentially large programme of works.</p> <p>Clarification required for A899 junction 3 Bear Scotland potential conflict with ongoing works at Houstoun Road SGN</p>
