<b>1.1</b>	GAM welcomed all.	
<b>2.0</b>	<b>Agree Previous Minutes</b>	
<b>2.1</b>	Previous minutes were read through. Agreed by LJ	
<b>3.0</b>	<b>Matters Arising from Previous Minutes</b>	
3.1	GAM mentioned that there have been some improvements made on 7 day noticing since previous meeting.	
3.2	The changes to traffic sensitive routes that were sent to the distribution list by email, no replies received. This has now been approved at SEARAUC.	
3.3	LJ thanked GAM, GM & JH for all their help regarding Tormy Wheel & Burnhead Bridge. LJ asked GAM to update the “risk register” to reflect shallow cables on the bridge. LJ states that Raymond McDonald will cover all costs in the future relating to the working around the shallow cables installed.	<b>LJ</b>
3.3a	GM (WLC) highlighted that the crossing of A801 Whiteside Railway Bridge has still to be resolved by SP to WLC’s satisfaction and WLC await SP’s proposals on this. Currently the track crossing this structure has only be temporarily reinstated. GM still awaiting confirmation.	
3.4	The first of the events to take place this year will be February 2019. Please ensure that clashes are looked at on the SRWR at all times. Events will cause major disruption to bus companies. Non-emergency road works are to be avoided during these times. Football matches at Almondvale stadium will be going on right through to April. The final fixtures for the last 6 games are still to be identified until this is resolved WLC will refrain from authorizing any road works from 3 April until	<b>All Utilities</b>

Diversion routes are posted on the WLC website so it has to be accurate. The dates should match, if not road closure or traffic lights. The road must be wide enough for give and take.
