Only one road closure planned in the Dundee area, for one overnight bridge inspection on St. Vincent Street (23rd Jan)

For the Angus area, road closure on Wellgate Arbroath, from 07/01/21 until 14/02/21, for the complete renewal of track and level crossing panels, and also a full closure at Barry level crossing from 22/01/21 until 14/02/21, for complete renewal of track and level crossing panels. Believed to be ongoing discussions regarding the closure of Barry LC due to the effect on surrounding businesses.
